AN ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT AND DEDICATE PLAZA DRIVE AS A PUBLIC STREET

WHEREAS, Council is desirous of accepting and confirming the dedication of Plaza Drive as a public street as shown on said plat in its current condition

Now Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio:


- Section 1: That the dedication to public use of Plaza Drive as shown on a dedication plat and described on the Easement and Right of Way agreement, attached as Exhibit A.
- Section 2: Council accepts and confirms this Plaza Drive in its current condition.
- Section 3: The Village Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Summit County Engineer's office and the Summit County Fiscal office.
- Section 4: That the cooperative agreement between the Village of Lakemore, Akron Center Associates, and County of Summit, Ohio, dictates the obligations between said parties for the improvement of Plaza Drive.
- Section 5: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio, for the reason that the appropriation is necessary for the continued operation of the Village of Lakemore. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately.



Now Therefore Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio:


- Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a cooperative agreement for the Village of Lakemore with Akron Center Associates and County of Summit, Ohio to obtain and improve the private drive ("Plaza Drive") at 1492-1540 Canton Road, Akron, Ohio, 44312.
- Section 2: This cooperative agreement states the terms and conditions upon which the Plaza Drive will become a dedicated public road, the Plaza Drive will be subsequently improved, and the cooperative parties will share in the cost of improving Plaza Drive
- Section 3: A copy of this cooperative agreement is attached hereto and made part hereof as if fully rewritten herein.
- Section 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio, for the reason that the appropriation is necessary for the continued operation of the Village of Lakemore. A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE SOLICITOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF GREEN, OHIO FOR FIRE DISPATCHING SERVICES

Now Therefore Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio:

- Section 1:** The Mayor and Village Solicitor are authorized to enter into an agreement with the City of Green, Ohio for Fire Dispatching Services. This agreement will be for a period commencing January 1, 2017, and ending December 31, 2018.

- Section 4:** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio, for the reason that the appropriation is necessary for the continued operation of the Village of Lakemore.
