AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO 1568-2016 "MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKEMORE, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2017"


Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio:

- Section 1: Council approves to increase revenues and expenses for Capital Improvement fund 4901-800-555-0000 Street, Highway, Sidewalks, and Curbs for the \$40,000.00 deposit being made by Akron Center Associates for the plaza drive
- Section 2: Council approves to increases expenses for General Fund Fire Contractual Services \$70,000.00
- Section 3: Council approves to reduce Fund 5701 Storm Water Enterprises Dues and Fees \$3,000.00
- Section 4: And the Village Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the Village Treasury for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of council to make the expenditure; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. It shall be provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village and for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.
- Section 5: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio, for the reason that the appropriation is necessary for the continued operation of the Village of Lakemore. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately.

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2017-2018 SUMMIT COUNTY
INTERGOVERNMENTAL MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR JOB CREATION
AND RETENTION AND TAX REVENUE SHARING

WHEREAS, the loss of jobs results in social and human costs which can be a significant burden to the area, the region and State, and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit and communities throughout the County recognize it is imperative to cooperate and collaborate with each other for the economic benefit of the region and its resident-taxpayers in order to attract and retain businesses and jobs; and

WHEREAS, there are many current and prospective employers who desire to remain or locate in the County of Summit; and

WHEREAS, the communities further recognize that cooperation is necessary for regional prosperity and enhancement of the local tax base and to successfully compete in global markets; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit, hereinafter "County", works with employers, prospective employers and individual communities within the County to provide tax and other incentives for purposes of retaining and locating prospective employers and facilities in communities within the County; and

WHEREAS, the communities further recognize that active attempts to relocate businesses from other local communities has a negative effect on economic development and growth in the region; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement is not intended to have any adverse impact on a business or company's decision to locate or relocate within the County but merely addresses the relationship of government bodies that may be affected by those independent business decisions; and

Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio:


Section 1: The Council of the Village of Lakemore hereby adopts the 2017-2018 Summit County Intergovernmental Memorandum of Understanding on Job Creation and Preservation and Tax Revenue sharing. This Memorandum of Understanding will be effective October 1, 2017, to June 30, 2018.

Section 3: Council further directs the Fiscal Officer to file, on behalf of the Village of Lakemore, the 2017-2018 Summit County Intergovernmental Memorandum of Understanding on Job Creation and Preservation and Tax Revenue sharing with the County of Summit immediately following adoption.



DEPARTMENT**


Now Therefore Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Lakemore,
