



You can do it!

It's easy to recycle in Lakemore!

Join your neighbors in helping to make our community and the environment cleaner for all of us. Here's what you need to know about our Residential Curbside Recycling Program to get started:

1. Just pick up your recycling bin at the Lakemore Municipal Building (1400 Main Street) between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. For details call 330-733-6125 ext. 4.
2. Discard only these types of items in your bin:
  - Paper and Cardboard (flattened and cut into sections)
  - Rigid Plastics (no lids; quick rinse)
  - Aluminum and other metal cans
  - Glass bottles and jars (both clear and colors)
  - Milk, juice, broth, soup and other food & beverage cartons
3. Set out your bin on your regularly scheduled trash pick up day
  - Place for pick up no later than 8:00 a.m. on your assigned day of pick up.
  - Holidays: If your trash pick up day falls on New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, or Christmas Day, it will be moved to the following day.
4. About tires and appliances, including those with Freon
  - Our recycling program accepts these at curbside for a fee of \$2.00 per tire and \$20 per appliance. These charges will appear on your bill.
5. Items NOT accepted for curbside recycling include:
  - Styrofoam, electronic waste, hazardous waste, used oil or oil containers, window panes / mirrors / ceramics, medical waste, electronic appliances, auto parts, hardware tools, clothing, shoes, garden hoses, hangers, light bulbs, fluorescent bulbs, metal items, railroad ties / spikes, chains, yard waste, food waste, toys, and trash

6. You will receive one bill for both trash and curbside recycling from the Village of Lakemore once every three months. For billing details, please call Municipal Services, 330-733-6125 ext. 4.
