

ORDINANCE NO. 1439– 2010

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PARKING OF
CAMPING/RECREATIONAL VEHICLES ON VILLAGE OWNED
PROPERTY**

**Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Lakemore,
Ohio:**

Section 1: The Council of the Village of Lakemore authorizes the Police to enforce parking restrictions on camping/recreational vehicles on any and all Village owned property. Any person found in violation of this Ordinance is guilty of a minor misdemeanor on a first offense.

Section 2: No camping/recreational vehicles shall be parked on Village owned properties, at any time, except:

- 1. The owner of the vehicle has obtained a permit from the Village of Lakemore to allow the parking of any camper/recreational vehicle for a specific time period.**
- 2. There is a Council approved special event requiring the parking of camper/recreational vehicles for a specific time period.**

Section 3: Any Ordinances or Resolutions or parts of Ordinances or Resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lakemore, Ohio for the reason that these vehicles parked on Village owned property create a nuisance for the general public. Therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
